ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

If you wish to be considered for the Surgical Technology program, you must meet all admission requirements by the end of the Summer semester prior to Fall entrance. The selection process will begin once all final grades are posted for the final semester of the Health Care Assistant Certificate. In order for a prospective student to be considered for admission into the Surgical Technology program, all of the following must apply:

- Letter of Interest submitted to the Admissions Office
- Must be 18 prior to the first day of program classes
- Completed the PSB (Psychological Services Bureau) exam at Ogeechee Technical College with the following results:
 - A cumulative score of 150 or higher
 - A 35 or higher on the Vocational Adjustment section
- Cumulative program grade point average (GPA) of at least a 2.5
 - Students must complete all courses within the Health Care Assistant Certificate (Surgical Technology track) with a "C" or better
 - Includes all attempts of required coursework for the Health Care Assistant Certificate within the previous five years. (A student may submit a waiver through the Admissions Office to have all coursework older than 5 years included in the calculations for competitive admissions. However, a student will not be able to choose specific coursework to include and exclude if a waiver is submitted.)
 - Grades from transfer credits will be included in the calculation of the cumulative program GPA.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Ogeechee Technical College determines a specific number of admission slots for each competitive admission program based on the availability of clinical sites and faculty. After all admissions requirements have been met, students will be selected for available slots using the following criteria:

- The highest total based upon the percentile score on the Vocational Adjustment section of the PSB Exam and the cumulative GPA.
 - The PSB Vocational Adjustment section will be weighted at 60% of the total
 - GPA will be weighted at 40% of the total
- If a tie exists, the highest percentile cumulative score on the PSB exam
- If a tie continues to exist, the highest percentile cumulative GPA
