("Homeless" means lacking fixed, regular, and adequate housing. You may be homeless if you are living in shelters, parks, motels or cars, or are temporarily living with other people because you had nowhere else to go. Also, if you are living in any of these situations and fleeing an abusive parent, you may be considered homeless even if your parent would provide support and a place to live.) and ("**Unaccompanied**" means you are not living in the physical custody of your parents or guardian.) and ("**Youth**" means you are 21 years of age or younger or you are still enrolled in High School as the day you signed and completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid – FAFSA)

- At any time on or after July 1, 2017, did your high school or school district homeless liaison determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless?
- At any time on or after July 1, 2017, did the director of an emergency shelter or transitional housing program funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless?
- At any time on or after July 1, 2017, did the director of a runaway or homeless youth basic center or transitional living program determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless or were self-supporting and at risk of being homeless?
