

**Altrusa Club of Statesboro Scholarship
Application Materials
2017-2018 Academic Year**

Purpose

To provide scholarship assistance to a female student who demonstrates maturity, a desire to succeed in the workplace, and has financial need. The main criteria for award of the scholarship will be how well the candidate meets the requirements specified within these materials.

The Altrusa Scholarship

Scholarship Funds:

1. The total scholarship will not exceed \$500.00 per academic term for the fall and spring terms.
2. The scholarship award may be applied towards tuition, books, and/or required fees.
3. Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the awardee upon proof of registration at the beginning of the academic term.

Recipient Eligibility:

1. Recipients must be residents of Bulloch County, Georgia.
2. Recipients must be enrolled as full-time students.
3. Recipients must maintain a minimum of a 3.0 GPA in order to be eligible for the scholarship from one academic term to another.

Procedures for Scholarship Award:

1. The Altrusa Scholarship Committee will accept applications from candidates until May 1, 2017.
2. Scholarship applicants will be interviewed by Committee members in May, 2017.
3. Scholarship awards will be announced by June 5, 2017.
 - a. Letters will be sent to all applicants thanking them for their application.
 - b. The Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee will notify the recipients of the award by letter.
 - i. The recipients will be presented to the entire organization at one of the scheduled meetings.

Criteria for Qualification as a Candidate

Submission Deadline: All applicants must submit a completed scholarship application to the Altrusa Scholarship Committee no later than May 1, 2017.

Statement of Purpose: All applicants are to include a separate statement of purpose that answers the following questions:

1. Why do you wish to be considered for this scholarship?
2. What are your plans after completion of your course of study?

Requirements for Applicants:

1. All applicants must submit proof of acceptance or a copy of their course registration for Fall, 2017, at Ogeechee Technical College.
2. Currently enrolled students must submit an official transcript from the OTC Registrar's Office that shows coursework completed.
3. Students with scholarships from other sources may apply for the Altrusa Scholarship with the understanding that because of limited funds, students with no other sources of grant or scholarship funding will be given priority.
4. All candidates must be interviewed in person by the Altrusa Scholarship Committee.
