- All college credit hours attempted after high school graduation (hours attempted while seeking a degree) at all postsecondary institutions attended and corresponding grades must be included in the HOPE cumulative GPA, regardless of what hours are accepted or not accepted by the institution the student is currently attending or if the course was repeated, or if the course was "forgiven" by the institution.
- HOPE Scholarship eligibility will be determined once grades are available for the term after you have attempted 30, 60 or 90 credit hours.
- A 3.0 GPA or better is required to be eligible for HOPE Scholarship at the end of the 30, 60 or 90 attempted credit hours and other stated checkpoints as specified by the HOPE program.
