PRE-PLANNING

Meet with your **HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR** to discuss whether Dual Enrollment is an option for you.

ADMISSION

New Dual Enrollment students will be asked to complete the **Dual Enrollment Application** and submit to OTC's High School Coordinator. The **High School Coordinator** will schedule you for the necessary placement exam if needed and walk you through the admission process. In addition, students will be asked to go to the **gafutures.org** website to apply for Dual Enrollment financial aid.

ADVISEMENT

Once admitted, students will work with the **HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR** and **HIGH SCHOOL COORDINATOR** to discuss course options.

ORIENTATION

Students will be scheduled to attend an **OTC Dual Enrollment ORIENTATION** prior to starting class.

ANY 9th-12th grade students enrolled in an eligible Georgia high school or home study program, who have achieved required scores on the college placement exam, are eligible to take part in the program. There are no residency or citizenship requirements.
