OUR STUDENTS

Ogeechee Technical College enrolled **3,182** students in credit courses during Academic Year 2024.

This was the full-time equivalent (FTE) of 1,658 students (based on the sum of total credit hours for all students). The College's Student Retention Rate is 68.7% of first-time, regular-admitted students enrolled in Fall 2022, who graduated or were still enrolled in a Georgia college/university or National Clearinghouse college as of the end of the next year (AY24).

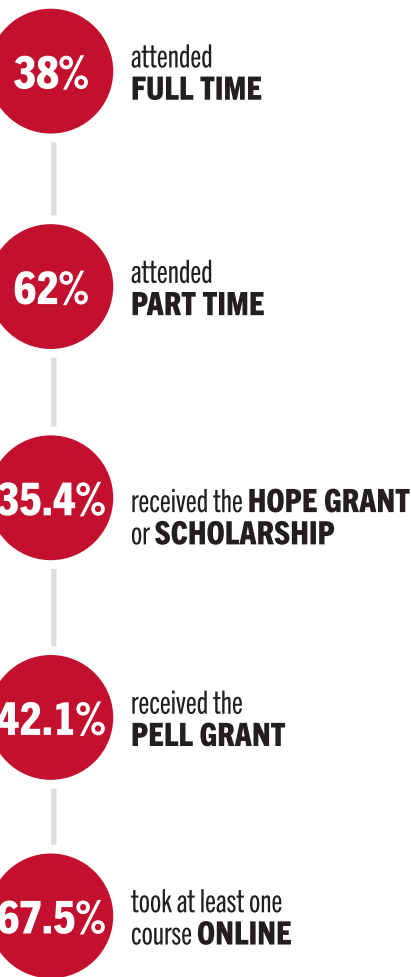
HIGH SCHOOL COLLABORATIVES
