

ATI TEAS Testing Process

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI TEAS) is a multiple-choice assessment that measures basic academic preparedness in Reading, Math, Science, English, and Language Usage.

Applicants for Diagnostic Medical Sonography (DMS), Echocardiography, and Radiologic Technology are required to take the ATI TEAS Allied Health Exam before the scheduled due date for program eligibility. DMS and Echo end of spring semester prior to fall program eligibility. Radiologic Technology end of summer semester prior to spring program eligibility.

Applicants will have the opportunity to sit for the ATI TEAS three times in a calendar year (January – December) with 30-days between each attempt. The applicants’ first attempt is \$40. A \$65 re-testing fee is required for each subsequent attempt. Applicants are allowed three attempts within a calendar year (January-December).

Applicants must have a composite score of 60% or higher in order to be considered for program eligibility. The highest composite score for each attempt will be used for competitive admission.

The ATI TEAS exam must be completed on the Ogeechee Technical College campus. Scores from other testing centers will not be accepted.
