

OTC Student Account Dashboard

 - o default password: capital first initial, lowercase last name initial, 6 digit birthdate

GSFC Funding App

You must complete a new funding app every summer

- Log into your GaFutures account
- Select HOPE and State Aid Applications
- Click Dual Enrollment Application (online) and complete the application
- Your parent and HS counselor will approve

You will be dropped from your classes if an approved DE funding app is not submitted by August 24!



State Requirement

In accordance with Georgia State Code O.C.G.A. § 20-3-519.1(b) and state Program Regulations, males that are US citizens or eligible non-citizens between 18 to 25 must be registered with the Selective Service System (SSS) to qualify for state aid programs.

A male student who is 18–25 and who has not registered may register online at the Selective Service website at www.sss.gov (processes in minutes)

May also complete a paper registration from available at a US Post Office or call SSS at: 847-688-6888


