


# **High School Equivalency (HSE) TESTING OPTIONS**

## Georgia has two testing options to earn your high school equivalency







**Computer-based format** 

**English or Spanish language** 

Can take one subject at a time

In-person and at-home testing available

Free test prepartation classes are available

Language Arts - Reading (65 mins) Language Arts - Writing (120 min) Mathematics (90min) Science (80 min)

### **Test Format:**

**Multiple choice questions** with written essay.

Reasoning through Language Arts (150 min) Multiple choice questions Mathematical Reasoning (115 min) Science (90 min)

Social Studies (70 min) Total Time: 425 min

### Test Format:

Drag and drop Fill in the blank Drop down Written essay

### Passing Score:

Total Time: 425 min

Take all five indivdual subtests in the same language and meet scoring criteria below: Score at least 8 out of 20 on each subtest

Score at least 2 out of 6 on the essay Achieve a total scale score of at least 45

### **Passing Score:**

Take all four individual subtests in the same language and meet the scoring criteria below:

Earn a minimum score of 145 out of 200 on each of the four subtests Score at least 2 out of 6 on the essay

#### **Retests:**

Two retakes are allowed per subject area within one calendar year There is a required 14 day wait between each test attempt (Test Center and/or HiSet@Home)

**Testing Centers:** Each subject area test has two retest options available before there is a 60 day wait between each subsequent retest Online Proctored Testing: Each subject test has only one retest option available before there is a 60 day wait between each subsequent retest



Subject area tests: \$26.75 each

Two restests per subject area: \$16 each\*

**Testing Fee | HiSET@Home:** 

Full Battery: \$181.25

Subject area tests: \$36.25 each

Two restests per subject area: \$25.50 each\*

\* Discount test fees apply if the rest occurs within 12 calendar months after a full price test

## **Testing Fee | Testing Centers:**

Full Battery: \$160

Subject area tests: \$40 each

Two restests per subject area: \$20 each\*

#### **Testing Fee | Online Proctored:**

Full Battery: \$184

Subject area tests: \$46each

Two restests per subject area: \$46each\*

\* Discount test fees apply if the rest occurs within 12 calendar months after a full price test

To test in Georgia, individuals must be at least 16 years of age (16 and 17 year olds must enroll in a state-approved adult education program and receive approval to test). Visit tcsg.edu/adult-education for more information.
