Federal Student Aid Programs: Your application was selected for review in a process called “Verification.” In this process, the Office of Financial Aid will be comparing information from your FAFSA application with your (and your spouse’s) financial documents. If there are differences between your application information and your financial documents, corrections to your FAFSA may be required.

Verification of 2019 IRS Federal Income Tax Return Information

The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) that is part of the FAFSA on the Web at www.fafsa.gov. In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2019 IRS income tax return information that was transferred into the student's FAFSA using the IRS DRT, **if that information was not changed**. If a student or parent changes his/her tax information on the student's FAFSA application after the original data was successfully matched with the IRS, Ogeechee Technical College will require the student to submit a 2019 Federal Tax Return Tax to verify if a correction needs to be made to the student's FAFSA.

In most cases, for electronic filers, 2019 IRS income tax return information for the IRS DRT is available within 2-3 weeks after the 2019 electronic IRS income tax return has been accepted by the IRS. Generally, for filers of 2019 paper IRS income tax returns, the 2019 IRS income tax return information is available from the IRS DRT within 8-11 weeks after the 2019 paper IRS income tax return has been received by the IRS. Contact the Office of Financial Aid, if more information is needed about using the IRS DRT.

If you are not able to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) you will need to use your 2019 personal tax return to fill out your 2021-2022 FAFSA.

Other Notes:

Individuals Granted a Filing Extension by the IRS:

If an individual is required to file a 2019 IRS Income tax return and has been granted a filing extension by the IRS, the individual must provide a copy of the IRS Form 4868, W-2 Forms, and if self-employed, a signed statement certifying the amount of the individual's AGI and U.S. Income taxes paid for tax year 2019.

Individuals Who Filed an Amended IRS Income Tax Return

If an individual filed an amended IRS income tax return for tax year 2019 provide both of the following: A signed copy of the original 2019 IRS income tax return that was filed with the IRS, or a **2019 IRS Tax Return Transcript** (signature not required) for the 2019 tax year; and a signed copy of the 2019 IRS Form 1040X "Amended U.S. Individual Tax Return" that was filed with the IRS.

Individuals Who Were Victims of IRS Identity Theft

A victim of IRS identity theft who has been unable to obtain a 2019 IRS Tax Return Transcript or use the IRS DRT, must provide a signed copy of the 2019 paper IRS income tax return that was filed with the IRS and a signed copy of IRS Form 14039 "Identity Theft Affidavit", if one was submitted to the IRS. If the individual was not required to submit one, he or she may provide a statement signed and dated by the individual indicating that he or she was a victim of IRS identity theft and that the IRS is investigating the matter. The statement must also indicate that the individual submitted a Form 14039 to the IRS, but did not keep a copy of it or that he or she was not required to file the form or a copy of a police report, if it was filed, related to the IRS identify theft.
