Ogeechee Technical College enrolled 3,029 students in credit courses during Academic Year 2021. This was the full-time equivalent (FTE) of 1,633 students (based on the sum of total credit hours for all students).

The College’s Student Retention Rate is 70% of first-time, regular-admitted students enrolled in Fall, who graduated or were still enrolled in a Georgia college or university as of the end of the next year (based on AY 2020 credit enrollment).


